



We have received a request to fill a prescription for your pet at an outside pharmacy. First requests will be approved with a written script that must be picked up by client. Additional approval for approved scripts will be done via fax. Before we provide you with a written prescription, we want to make sure you are aware that:

1. If your pet has a reaction, **to a medication or food purchased from our office**, we can work with the manufacturer to cover the cost of treatment of adverse reactions and/or failure of the medication to prevent disease. *This is not true for medications or food purchased elsewhere.*
2. The number of tablets, capsules, milligram size of the unit, volume may differ from what your veterinarian prescribed.
3. The manufacture's warranties or guarantees for these products may not be valid. Hebron Animal Hospital will be unable to assist you in claims against the manufactures.
4. Products obtained from other sources may be counterfeit and may not have been approved by the appropriate governing authority.
5. Some medications shipped from other countries, may not follow the same FDA qualifications as those in the U.S. These sites may sell unapproved drugs, drugs that contain the wrong active ingredient, drugs that may contain too much or too little of the active ingredient, or drugs that contain dangerous ingredients.
6. If refills are still available the client is responsible for transferring the prescription to another pharmacy if they wish to do so.
7. Online pharmacy and outside pharmacy staff are not medically trained in veterinary pharmacology.
8. It is the client's responsibility to contact the outside pharmacy with any medication problems and report reactions.

For health reasons your pet must maintain a current doctor client patient relationship and receive an exam every 6 months to be eligible for any medications to be prescribed.

As always, the doctors and staff of Hebron Animal Hospital are committed to the health and safety of your pet. We request the waiver to be signed for a Release of Liability. By signing this document, you acknowledge that we have informed you that purchasing prescription drugs from an outside pharmacy may be harmful to your pet. You accept any and all responsibility financial or otherwise, that may occur from your decision. You understand that Hebron Animal Hospital will be held harmless from the use of products and/or prescriptions purchased from sources outside the hospitals monitoring and control.
